Prof. Marie Schaer

Marie Schaer is a Child Psychiatrist and Assistant Professor at the Department of Psychiatry of the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Geneva. Since 2016, Marie Schaer has been the doctor in charge of the Autism Outpatient Clinic and the Centre for Early Intervention in Autism, in parallel with her mandate as SNSF Scholar Professor during which she continues her research on brain development in young children with an autism spectrum disorder.
