

Abstract Guidelines SSDV 2026

Thank you for your interest in the SSDV congress and submitting your abstract. Please find here all relevant information you will need.

1. Guidelines

1. Abstracts may be [submitted online only](#). Start of the submission is **3rd March 2026**.
2. Abstract deadline is **31st May 2026**.
3. Submission of an abstract constitutes agreement with publication of the abstract, if accepted, in the SSDV congress special edition of *Dermatologica Helvetica*. Your abstract will be printed as submitted.
4. Submission of an abstract constitutes a commitment by the author(s) to present, if accepted.
5. Presenting authors of accepted abstracts must register for the SSDV conference.
6. Posters submitted by companies are not considered for best poster awards (see below).
7. Posters submitted by companies are subject to a charge of 1,000, Swiss Francs unless it is included in your package as an exhibitor (A *Platin sponsor has the right to 3 abstracts/posters free of charge, Gold: 2 poster and Silver 1 poster, please indicate the name of the organisation*).
8. The platform used by SSDV is offered to you by the platform of Organizers. The submitting author will need to open a personal account. If you have submitted abstracts before using the same platform you should have a login already.
9. Your personal login valid for future use, e.g., should you wish to edit or correct a submitted abstract or if you submit further abstracts to the SSDV conference or to any other future conference which uses Organizers as a provider. Renewed entry of your contact details will be unnecessary.
10. The content of Abstracts must be submitted in English, presentations of accepted abstracts may be held in German, French or English.
11. Please structure your abstract using the following headings for original scientific work:
Background / Objective / Results / Conclusion.
For case reports/case series use the following headings:
Background / Observation(s) / Conclusion.
12. The maximum length for the abstract is 250 words. Do not add any reference, tables, charts or graphics.
13. Clarity of expression will be considered in the review process. The overall quality of language used should assure comprehension by the reader.
14. There is no limit to the number of abstracts an investigator may submit. Abstracts that appear to be replicate versions of a single study may be rejected.
15. Please limit the number of authors listed to those who have substantially contributed to the abstract. If authors' names appear on more than one abstract, their names must appear and be spelled identically on each abstract to facilitate proper indexing.



Enter every author's name into a separate field for indexing. There will be a **maximum of 10 contributed authors**.

16. Do not use abbreviations in the title. Limit their use to commonly used abbreviations and expand all abbreviations at first mention.
17. After having submitted your abstract, you will receive a confirmation by email with a reference number of your abstract(s), (for inquiry and correspondence purposes).
18. Submitted abstracts after the review process may be edited only with accordance with the SSDV. If you do not receive a confirmation, please contact us at registration@organizers.ch.
19. Abstracts will be subject to peer review.
20. Posters as PDF in A0-portrait format, (*Dimensions: 84.1 x 118.9 cm*) can be submitted to the deadline of **2nd August 2026**. The SSDV will print the poster with contribution of a partner.
21. Posters in A0 portrait format (dimensions: 84.1 × 118.9 cm) must be uploaded to your personal account until **2nd August 2026**. **Printing will be coordinated** and covered by SSDV. If the deadline is missed, the poster must be printed to the venue.
22. The format of presentation will be decided on by the scientific committee, based on the quality of the abstracts submitted.
23. Authors will be informed by beginning of July 2026 on the decision of the scientific committee (please make sure to state your correct email address). Detailed information on installation and presentation of posters and oral presentations will be mailed directly to authors of accepted abstracts.
24. A Committee delegated by the board of SSDV supervises the abstract submission and reviewing process.

2. Topics

Please carefully select the topic under which you submit your abstract for review. A review board will verify the correct allocation of abstracts and may re-allocate your abstract prior to the review process if placed incorrectly. Please indicate as well if your abstract is issue of a scientific study or a case report series.

- *Inflammatory and immune-mediated dermatoses*
- *Infectious Diseases (including STD-STI)*
- *Psychodermatology*
- *Dermato-Oncology*
- *Corrective dermatology, Dermato-Cosmetics, lasers*
- *Therapy, diagnostic tools, and devices*
- *Dermato-Paediatrics*
- *Dermato-Allergology (--> qualifies automatically for the Bruno Bloch Award)*
- *Dermato-Pathology*
- *Basic and Translational Research*
- *Genodermatoses (--> qualifies automatically for the U.W. Schnyder Award)*
- *Surgery*



3. Publication

All accepted abstracts will be published in the special congress edition of *Dermatologica Helvetica*. By submitting abstracts, authors agree to allow publication and/or sharing over social media platforms and www.derma.swiss.

4. Poster Prizes

Please note that posters submitted by companies are not considered for best poster awards. Before the congress, Juries will select posters in the following three categories:

SSDV Prizes for best posters

The three best posters will be recognized by the SSDV with **1,500, 1,000 and 500** Swiss francs respectively. The jury is appointed by the Scientific Committee of the organizing clinic in Zurich.

Bruno Bloch Poster prize

The Bruno Bloch Foundation awards a prize for the best poster in the field of dermatology-allergology. The jury is chaired by Prof. Thomas Kündig.

Urs W. Schnyder Poster Prize

Every year, the U.W. Schnyder Foundation awards a poster in the field of Genodermatoses. The jury is chaired by Prof. Luca Borradori.

5. Poster presentations

- Oral presentation
The jury decides on **4 to 6 posters to be presented** during the Free Communication Session (*Workshop, Thursday, 29th august 2026, from 9.15 to 10.00am in the Auditorium*).
- Poster Exhibition (Thursday - Friday, August 26th and 27th 2026)
The posters will be **available on an online platform** as well **on site in the main hall** at the Messe Zürich during all three congress days in the exhibition room.

The Scientific Committee will organise a guided **poster walk** to the following 3 categories:

- Inflammatory and immune-mediated dermatoses
- Dermato-Oncology and interventions
- Basic science

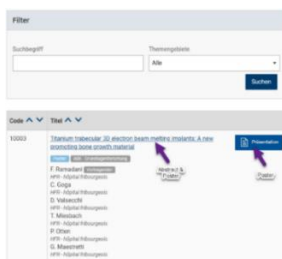

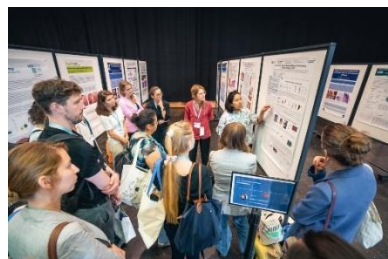
- All posters must be delivered in **portrait**-format
- Please make sure that your **poster number** (e.g. P 01) is clearly visible on your poster
- Poster format of the printed version in the exhibition will be defined with the format:
A0-portrait: Dimensions: 84.1 x 118.9 cm
- **All Posters will be printed from the SSDV, submissions until 8th August**
- All Posters that have been submitted **after the deadline** must organize the printing separately. The responsibility lies with the author
All submitted Posters will be integrated in an exhibition walk (27.08.26, 12h00 – 12.30 pm)
- All accepted posters will be published as well electronically in an online gallery
- There will be a poster exhibition on site at the Messe Zürich
- All e-Posters are made accessible to congress participants, on their personal computer, if they log in to the platform. The gallery will be published right before the congress.

^E-Posters are fully searchable according to key metadata

- Participants with a log-in can download all E-Posters as pdf-files
- Participants can get in contact with the authors on site during the poster-walk session
- E-Posters can accommodate a variety of content types, including abstracts, references to videos, posters, proceedings, datasets, and more
- Accepted formats are:
 - Poster submission file: PDF, maximum file size 100MB,
- The posters will be presented in the exhibition until the last congress break (Friday, 29.08.26- appr. 3h15pm) the physical posters will be deleted. If your wish to keep your personal poster, please collect it during the last break
